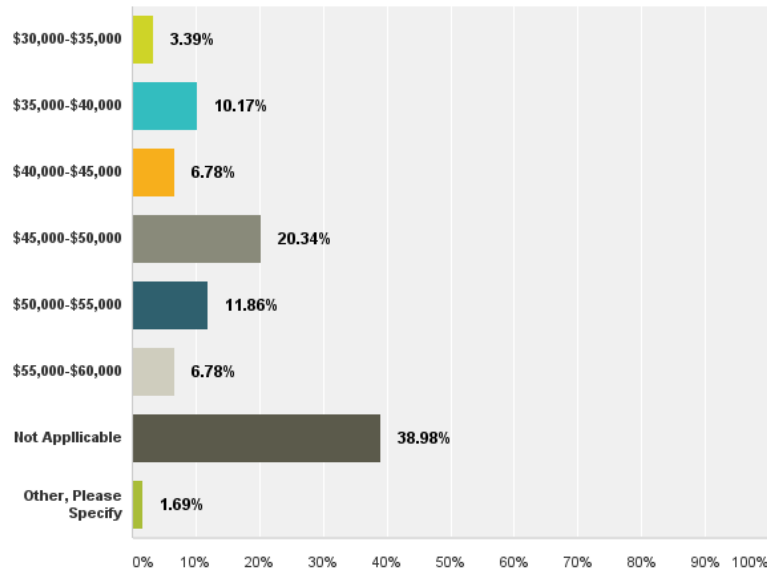


2014 WYOCPA Salary Survey

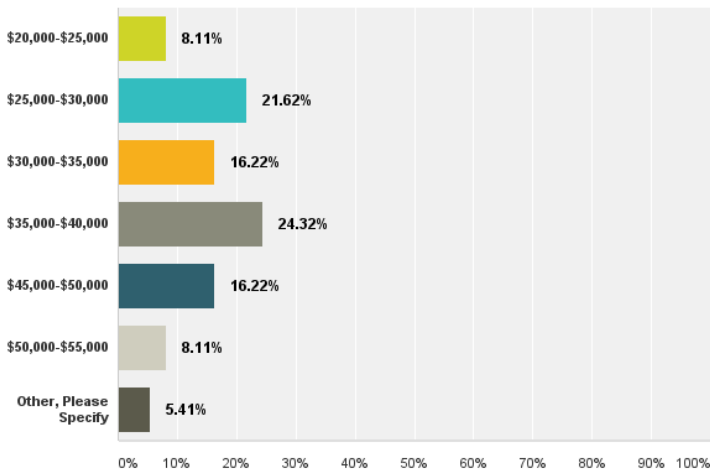
Q8 If hiring, what can a new hire who has passed the CPA exam expect to earn annually ?

Answered: 59 Skipped: 6



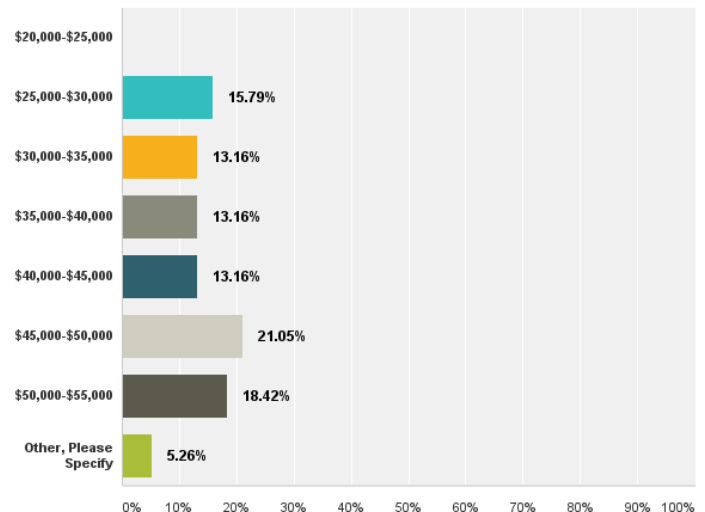

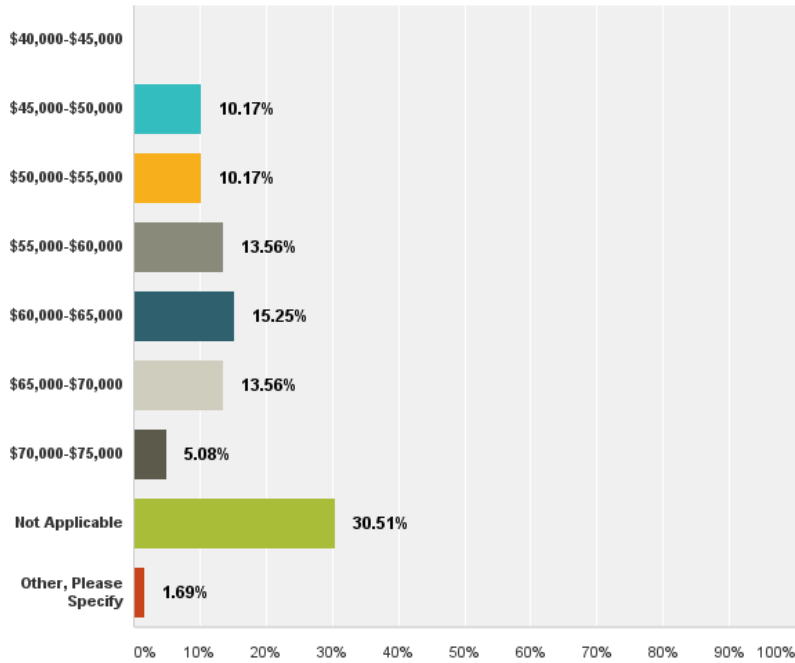

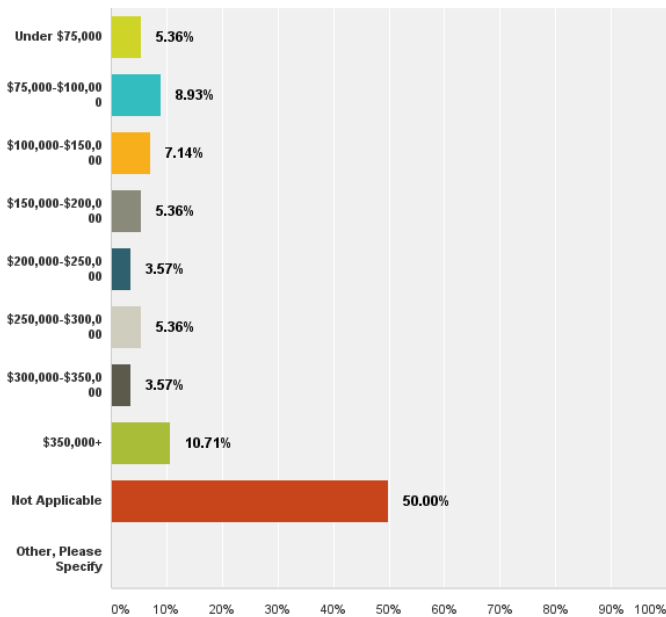
Q10 What can a CPA with three to five years experience expect to earn annually?

Answered: 59 Skipped: 6



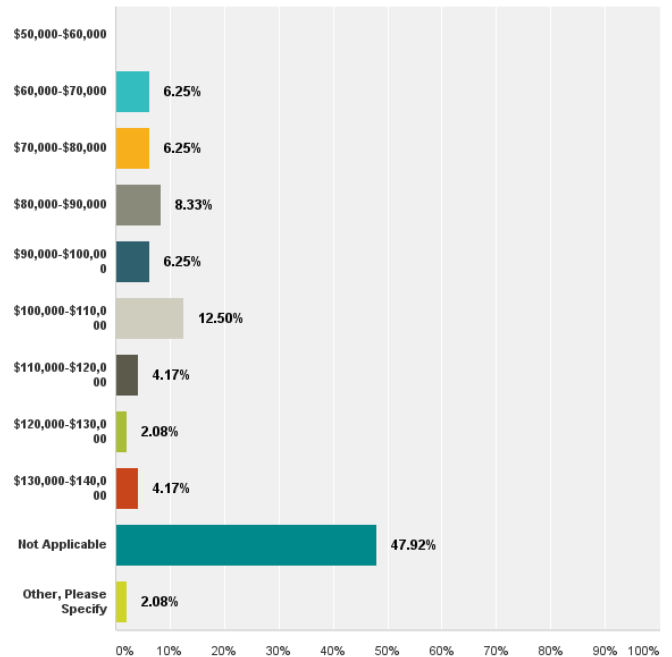
Q14 Please indicate a salary range for your highest paid partner in your public accounting firm.

Q12 For those CPAs not in public practice, what can a CPA expect to earn annually after obtaining an Executive Position or similar?

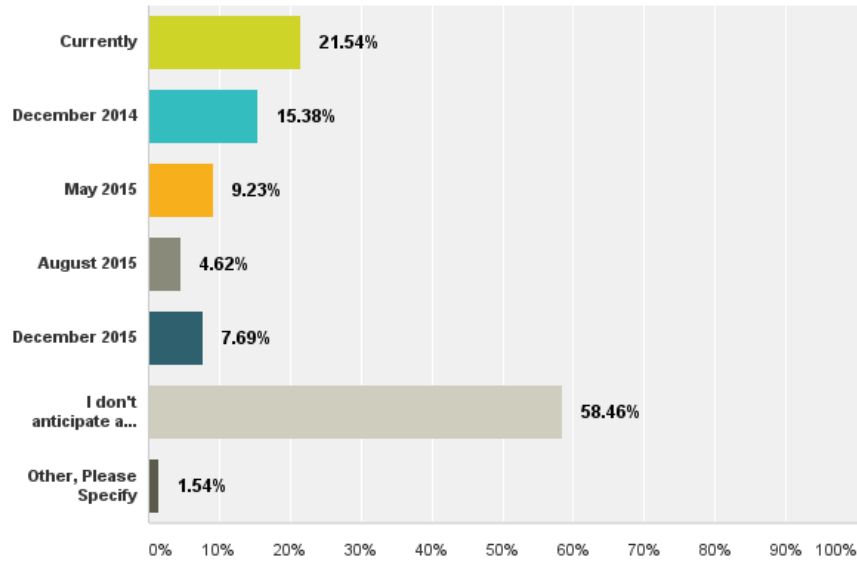

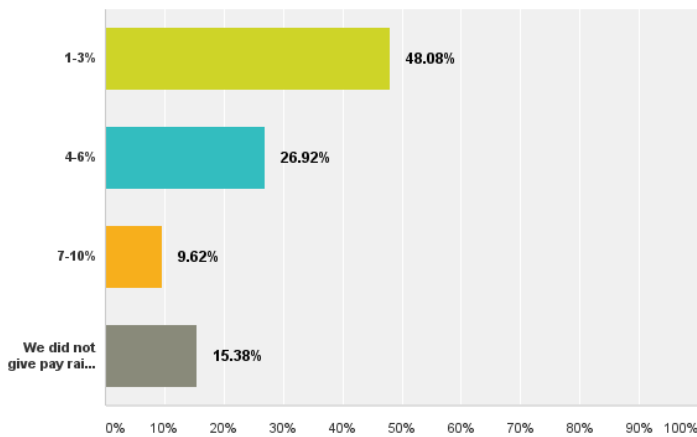
Q4 Does your business anticipate openings in: (please check all that apply)
